Job placement rate context:

Who is included?

This rate includes all students who completed between July 1, 2010 and June 30, 2011 that did not sign employability waivers.

What type of job?

All jobs in-field of study and related fields of study, including divers, tenders, hyperbaric chamber technicians, diving supervisors and scuba instructors.

When were they employed?

This rate is based on program completers who were employed within 90 days of completion and were employed for at least 30 days.

How were graduates tracked?

CDA has a Graduate Services department who contacts the students after graduation to ensure they find a job and then follows up with their employer 30 days after they start to verify the placement.

What agencies is this rate reported to?

CDA reports a placement rate to Accrediting Council for Continuing Education and Training (ACCET), which requires the rate to be calculated from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>, so that rate is different than the rate calculated above. The most recently reported placement rate to ACCET is 84.75%.
