



Student Portion of the CARES Act Emergency Fund Relief

The Department of Education has asked institutions that have received the student portion of their Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund allocation, which will be used to make emergency grants to student's institutions to make easily accessible to the public- via the institution's website- the following items:

- To date CDA has aid 44 students \$76,120, we have 27 remaining.
- The total amount of funds that the institution received under the HEERF is \$122,862.
- The estimated total number of students at the Institute under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 there were 71 estimated students to be eligible to receive the HEERF.
- The total amount of students who have received the emergency financial aid grant is 44 students.
- All students whom were displaced are how the institution determined which students would receive the emergency financial aid grant and how much funding they did or will receive.
- Students were sent applications to apply and return concerning the emergency financial aid grant.

Reporting clock begins 30 days from the date the institution signed the certification and agreement. Although ED has recently changed that date from when the institution received its student portion of the HEERF.
